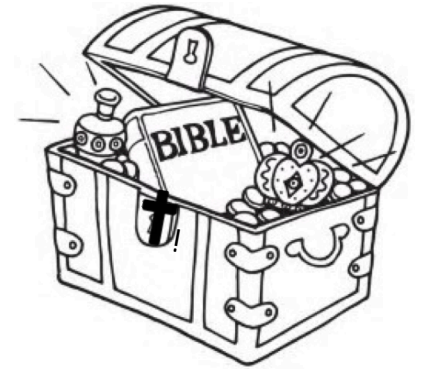


TREASURE HUNT

1. What do you do immediately before sitting down in your seat?
2. Spend a few minutes in silent prayer. Pray for God to help you, your family, friends, and those who are less fortunate.
3. What do we call the seat/bench you are sitting on in church?
4. Besides the priest, who are the other people on the altar?
5. How many people on the altar are wearing shoes?
6. How many candles are lit ON THE ALTAR?
7. Whose picture is hanging on the altar?
8. How many small crosses are hanging on the walls around the church?
9. What is the Armenian word for "cross?"
10. What is the name of the "cup" where the priest puts the Communion (*Nushkhar*) and wine?



When you go up for Communion, look carefully at the priest's Chalice. Draw a picture of it on the back of this paper.

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"¹Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian, and he led the flock to the far side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. ²There the angel of the Lord appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush. Moses saw that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up. ³So Moses thought, "I will go over and see this strange sight—why the bush does not burn up." ⁴When the Lord saw that he had gone over to look, God called to him from within the bush, "Moses!
